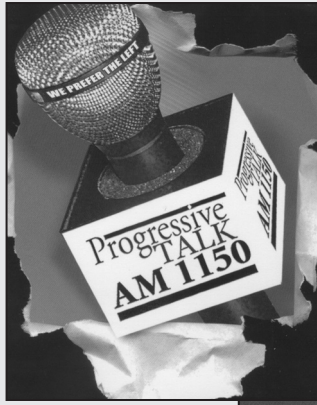


Morning Time is Miller Time

Imagine...

Imagine that you live in a country where the government makes constant use of patriotic mottos, slogans, symbols, etc. Flags are seen on clothing and in public displays.

Imagine that you live in a country where a great fear of enemies causes people to be persuaded that certain human rights can be ignored. People might tend to look the other way from long incarcerations of prisoners or even torture.

Imagine that you live in a country where “enemies” are identified in order to unify the masses. The people are worked into a patriotic frenzy against a common threat such as ethnic minorities, gays, liberals, religious groups, communists, etc.

Imagine that you live in a country where the military gets the largest share of government funding even though there may be large domestic problems.

Imagine that you live in a country where there is rampant sexism. The government is very male dominated. Abortion and homosexuality are suppressed and the state becomes the guardian of the family institution.

Imagine that you live in a country where the mass media is directly or indirectly controlled by government regulations. The media is run by spokespeople sympathetic to the government. Censorship is common and is viewed as not a danger.

Imagine that you live in

a country where fear concerning national security is used to control the masses.

Imagine that you live in a country where religion and the government are intertwined. Religious terminology is frequently used by government officials to shape public opinion even when espoused principles of the common religious beliefs are contrary to the government's policies or actions.

Imagine that you live in a country where the power of the corporation is protected because industrial and business leaders are directly responsible for putting the governing leaders in power. These two groups feed and support each other.

Imagine that you live in a country where labor power is suppressed. Anything that seeks to check the unlimited power of the corporations is suppressed or eliminated.

Imagine that you live in a country where there is a disdain for higher education and academics. Professors can be persecuted or censored and funding for education is cut.

Imagine that you live in a country where crime and punishment becomes an obsession. People become willing to overlook police abuses and give up civil liberties in the name of patriotism. There might be a national police force with unlimited power.

Imagine that you live in a country where corruption and cronyism are rampant.

The government is made up of cronies and friends who pass the appointments back and forth and use their authority to protect each other from accountability. Resources and funds can often be misappropriated or stolen in plain view.

Imagine that you live in a country where elections are fraudulent. This can happen through technical manipulation of the polls. It can also happen by manipulation of voting district boundaries, voting eligibility lists and by smear campaigns promoted in the subservient media.

Here's a multiple-choice question:

Does any of this remind you of a real country?

- A Germany under Hitler
- B Italy under Mussolini
- C Spain under Franco
- D Indonesia under Suharto
- E America under Bush, Jr.
- F All of the above

Sound too far-fetched to be true? Not to the citizens of Hitler's Germany and not to those Italians who lived under Mussolini's rule just seventy years ago. Not to Suharto's Indonesia, less than a decade ago. Not to millions who live today under dictators and despots around the globe. Not to millions today whose punishment for free speech and freedom of assembly means imprisonment and even death under the iron-fisted rule of monarchies, theocracies and plutocracies.

The question every American must ask himself is: where are we headed

under our current administration? What was once a three-branch system of representational government with checks and balances has been streamlined to one-party rule. This allows the one party absolute power and unilateral decision-making, the handing out of taxpayer monies to the favored, and the punishment of any who oppose.

It's not too hard to imagine where we are headed when the mother of a dead war veteran is hand-cuffed, arrested and thrown out of the nation's Capitol for merely wearing a T-shirt that has a number on it. It's not too hard to imagine when voting districts are redrawn illegally in Texas and no one from the state or federal government intervenes. It's not too hard to imagine when billions in taxpayers' money is hand-



ed out to companies whose stock is held by the heads of our government. It's not too hard to imagine it; we're already there.
