Beachwood Canyon's Wildflowers

Despite ever more houses, this canyon remains a refugium for some of California's loveliest wildflowers—some of which are quite rare. At any time in the year it is possible to locate elusive plants growing out of our roadcuts and along our trails. Winter, spring, and early summer are spectacular and among the dry grasses of summer and fall, numerous members of the sunflower family can be found in full bloom.

We are a year-round wilderness masquerading as a dry hillside canyon. Look closer to find the natural wonders in Beachwood Canyon.

Some rare species survive here, and it is important to protect them since picking destroys their reproductive cycle. Enjoy our flora.
